WHAT IS THE PURPOSE?

The purposes of the Society are:

- To make a safe adequate haemapheresis technique for the collection of donor cells or the removal of blood constituents available to patients through apheresis units in blood banks, hospitals and other institutions.
- To encourage, advance and certify high standards of administrative and technical performances in the field of haemapheresis to apheresis units in blood banks, hospitals and other institutions.
- To foster scientific investigation, clinical application, education and exchanges of information and ideas, related to haemapheresis and allied fields in clinical and laboratory medicine.
- All other purposes which benefit safe and adequate haemapheresis practice in patients care.
- To improve scientific and professional exchange between different clinical and theoretical specialities and industry.
- To contribute to evidence-based use of blood products.
- To preserve donor safety and reduce risks for recipients of blood products.

MEMBERSHIP

Persons will be eligible for membership to the Society by submitting an application to the membership committee (send the application form on back page).

Individual members should show qualifications satisfying one or more of the following categories defined by E.S.F.H. bylaws:

BYLAWS published at www.esfh.eu

- Physicians in Europe who are (a) duly licensed to practise medicine within the country in which they practise, or (b) in internships or residency training, or (c) who may not be licensed but are employed by agencies of a national government or the Council of Europe or the World Health Organization or other comparable institutions as decided by the board.
- Technical workers, nurses and other health professionals with or without baccalaureate degrees who are actively involved in functions of a haemapheresis unit.
- Scientists living in Europe having advanced degrees, including physicians who may not yet be licensed to practise medicine in any of the European countries, and who have recent experience in teaching, research, service or administration relating to haemapheresis.
- Physicians, technical workers, nurses, other health professionals and scientists living outside Europe and who meet the requirements as listed here before in paragraphs A,B,C.
- Persons who are engaged in administrative or donor recruitment activities related to haemapheresis units in blood banks, hospitals or other institutions.
- Public-spirited citizens such as members of blood banks or hospital boards, and others who have made outstanding contributions to haemapheresis.
